### **Registrations Open for the Luxembourg Song Contest 2027**

Registrations are now open to find Luxembourg's representative for Eurovision Song Contest 2027.

Since Luxembourg's return to the ESC in 2024, the Luxembourg Song Contest has served as the national final through which the Grand Duchy's Eurovision representative is selected.

Artists wishing to compete and perform at the fourth edition of the LSC on the Rockhal stage are invited to submit their applications starting Thursday, 9 July, via <https://eurovision.rtl.lu/registration>.

### **Expanding Opportunities Through a Dual Application Process**

For this upcoming edition, and to maximise opportunities for Luxembourg's artistic talent, artists and songs will be selected through two parallel application processes.

### **Artist Applications Open Until 20 September**

Singers, performing artists and music groups who wish to represent Luxembourg at the LSC/ESC may apply for the auditions without being attached to a specific song in advance.

To be eligible, applicants must be at least 18 years old on 15 January 2027 and demonstrate a strong connection to Luxembourg by meeting one of the following criteria: hold Luxembourgish nationality; or have resided in the Grand Duchy for three consecutive years; or demonstrate a genuine involvement in Luxembourg's music scene (e.g. regular participation in local festivals and events).

Applicants must also be widely available between November 2026 and May 2027 for the preparation and promotion of the LSC and ESC.

Naturally, candidates must be able to perform live and feel comfortable performing on a large stage. A maximum of six people may appear on stage.

The deadline for submitting applications is 20 September 2026 at 23:59 CET.

Auditions will take place in mid-October 2026 before an international jury of Eurovision experts, who will pre-select candidates for the Luxembourg Song Contest.



## **Song Submissions Open Until 29 October**

Songs proposed for the LSC 2027 are subject to a separate application process, open via [eurovision.lu](http://eurovision.lu) until 29 October 2026.

Songwriters and composers from Luxembourg and abroad are invited to submit songs for Luxembourgish performers.

Songs must not exceed three minutes in length and must not have been released or publicly performed before 1 September 2026. The choice of language is entirely open, and songs in Luxembourgish are very welcome.

A panel of music and/or Eurovision experts will pre-select songs with strong Eurovision potential that will be presented to the shortlisted candidates.

## **A Pairing Workshop to Bring Artists and Songs Together**

Artists and selected songs will come together during a Pairing Workshop, scheduled for late October/early November.

During the workshop, artists will receive guidance from industry experts, including coaches, musicians and Eurovision specialists, to help them select the song that best showcases their artistic identity and gives them the strongest chance of success at Eurovision. The chosen song may be one written by the artist themselves or a composition submitted by another songwriter.

At the conclusion of this collaborative process, the finalists of the Luxembourg Song Contest will be selected and can begin preparing for the competition.

## **The LSC Returns to Rockhal on 30 January 2027**

The next edition of the Luxembourg Song Contest will take place on 30 January 2027 at the Rockhal in Belval, where Luxembourg's representative for the Eurovision Song Contest 2027 will be chosen.

In 2026, eight finalists competed in the national final, and Eva Marija won the Luxembourg Song Contest with *Mother Nature*, going on to represent the Grand Duchy in Vienna last May.

Following Dara's victory with *Bangaranga*, the next Eurovision Song Contest will be held in Bulgaria in mid-May 2027. The host city and exact dates will be announced later this summer.



In accordance with the mandate entrusted to it by the Luxembourg Government, RTL Lëtzebuerg is responsible for the organisation and coordination of Eurovision activities in Luxembourg, including both the Luxembourg Song Contest and Luxembourg's participation in the Eurovision Song Contest.
