## UK Transition Period: A message for UK Nationals living in Luxembourg

---

Dear

The UK Transition Period ends on 31 December 2020, and the Withdrawal Agreement protects your right to continue to live, work and study in Luxembourg as a UK national broadly as you do now. However, there are some actions you need to take. This letter explains the steps you may need to take around residency, healthcare, driving and passport validity.

### **ACTION YOU NEED TO TAKE NOW:**

#### **1. Apply for residency**

You need to apply for a new residence status in Luxembourg, unless you also hold the nationality of an EU/EFTA Member State or you are the holder of a “carte de légitimation”. To find out how to do this, visit: [gov.uk/livinginluxembourg](http://gov.uk/livinginluxembourg)

You should keep documentation of your residency in case you need it in the future.

#### **2. Check your access to healthcare and register with your healthcare authority if necessary**

**S1 form holders:** If you have a UK S1 (E121) form, register it locally, if you have not already done so, to access state healthcare in Luxembourg. If you are entitled to an S1 form, but

If you get a UK State Pension you will carry on getting it.
