1. WHAT EXACTLY IS INDIACA?

Indiaca is a team sport played on a court divided by a net, much like volleyball. It is a rally game in which the ball, known as the Indiaca, is struck with the flat of the hand over the net in such a way that the opposing team cannot return it. Two teams, each with five field players, face each other on the court and try to score as many points as possible. The aim is to hit the Indiaca over the net so that it touches the ground in the opponents' half or the opponents make a mistake.

2. WHAT DOES THE INDIACA LOOK LIKE?

The Indiaca is a flat, yellow leather handball with four red turkey feathers. The guide feathers, which can be replaced at any time, are between 18 and 20 centimetres long and ensure that the Indiaca flies in the desired direction and always lands on the padded cushion facing the opponent. The ball weighs between 50 and 60 grams and its striking surface has a diameter of 7 to 8 centimetres.



3. HOW DO YOU PLAY INDIACA?

In many respects, the rules of Indiaca are similar to those of volleyball. For example, within a team, the Indiaca may be hit or touched with the hand or forearm three times, but not twice in a row by the same player. By the third contact at the latest, the Indiaca must be played over the net. The game begins with a serve. Play continues until the Indiaca touches the ground or a team commits a fault. The winner of the rally receives one point. If the serving team commits a fault, the opposing team also gains the right to serve.

The players on each team rotate positions clockwise, so that during the course of the game all players take on both attacking and defensive roles. The team that first wins two sets of 25 points each wins the match. The game is played on a court measuring 16 x 6.10 meters. Depending on the age and gender of the players, the net height ranges from 2.00 to 2.35 meters.



4. WHAT SKILLS DOES AN INDIACAPLAYER NEED TO MASTER?

To play Indica, a number of basic technical skills are essential. These include the serve, the basic shot, the arched shot, the drop shot, the smash and the block. In competition, precision, quick reactions, jumping ability, hitting power, awareness and coordination among the players are also important, as is the ability to master and apply various tactical variations within a well-rehearsed team. In addition to the individual skills of each player, a cohesive team structure is therefore of central importance. Without team spirit and an instinctive understanding between all teammates, a team cannot play successfully together in the long term.



5. WHERE DOES THIS SPORT COME FROM?

The origins of Indiaca can be traced back to the indigenous peoples of South America. The game has been played for several hundred years as a folk sport under the name Peteka. In 1936, whilst out walking along Copacabana, the German PE teacher Karlhans Krohn observed some young people playing Peteka. The unusual equipment and the movements involved in the game caught his interest.

The locals called the ball a 'peteka', a pouch sewn together from pieces of leather, filled with sawdust and adorned with colourful feathers. It is believed that the original form of the peteka was an archaic shuttlecock made from folded maize leaves, which researchers discovered amongst Native American tribes in north-eastern Bolivia. Krohn bought a few of these shuttlecocks, took them back to Germany and subsequently set about developing them further himself, improving their flight characteristics. He named his first mass-produced ball 'Indiaca', a combination of the words 'Indian' and 'peteka'. Initially, Indiaca spread very quickly in Germany as a recreational game. It was only later that it developed into a fully-fledged competitive sport. From Germany, where Indiaca was a regular feature of the German Gymnastics Festival, amongst other events, the sport, which had been further developed by South Americans, spread to numerous other countries, including Luxembourg.



An official Luxembourg Indiacca Championship has been held since 1999, and a National Cup Competition has been held in addition to this since 2004. The IFL has also set itself the goal of raising awareness of Indiacca across all regions of Luxembourg and therefore takes part in multi-sport events such as the DTB Sports Festival, as well as various school sports days and summer activities organised by different local authorities.

8. HOW HAS LUXEMBOURG CONTRIBUTED TO INTERNATIONAL INDIACCA?



A major milestone for Indiacca in Luxembourg was the hosting of the OPEN JUNIOR WORLD CUP 2014 in Ettelbruck, featuring youth teams from Useldange, Bettendorf, and Alzingen. In addition, Bettendorf's OPEN Men and OPEN Women teams regularly compete in the German Indiacca League and participate in numerous international tournaments.

Another highlight followed in 2022, when Luxembourg hosted the 6th Indiacca World Championship at the Coque in Luxembourg-Kirchberg. The successful organization of this major international event further strengthened Luxembourg's reputation within the international Indiacca community.

9. WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE PEOPLE OF LUXEMBOURG AHEAD OF THE 2026 OPEN JUNIOR WORLD CUP?

When it comes to the youth teams, assessing their international level is not always easy, as many teams are less well known than those in the open or senior divisions. Nevertheless, the Luxembourg teams have realistic chances of winning medals. In interviews, the players expressed their excitement about meeting new people and finally competing against international opponents. The tournament will feature a diverse field of participants, including Japan for the first time, Poland returning after an absence, a strong German delegation, and teams from Switzerland. Luxembourg will be represented in all categories by teams from Indiacca Bettendorf.

10. WHAT IS THE CURRENT DEVELOPEMENT OF INDIACA SPORTS?

Overall, the awareness, popularity, and quality of Indiacca continue to grow worldwide. It is now up to the International Indiacca Association (IIA) to build on this momentum and further establish the sport internationally. In Luxembourg, efforts should focus on attracting new players beyond the existing Indiacca strongholds in order to expand the sport and encourage the formation of new clubs. The hosting of the OPEN JUNIOR WORLD CUP 2026 in Vianden may also help increase the popularity of Indiacca among children and young people in the years to come.
